



‘ABDALLĀH KABRĪ

‘ABDALLĀH B. EBRĀHĪM AL-KABRĪ ABŪ ḤAKĪM, mathematician, d. 476/1083-84. He was the pupil of Ḥosayn b. Moḥammad al-Vannī (killed in Baghdad in Du’l-ḥejja, 451/January-February, 1060). According to Ebn Ḳallekān (tr. de Slane, I, p. 421), Ḳabrī wrote a *Talkīṣ fi’l-ḥesāb* (“Summary concerning computation”).
