



'ABDALLĀH B. NAJĀŠĪ

'ABDALLĀH B. NAJĀŠĪ, ABŪ BOḤAYR B. ĠANIM B. SAM'ĀN ASADĪ NAŞRĪ, Shi'ite governor of Ahvāz under the caliph Manşūr (136-58/754-75), remembered as the transmitter of a short text, *Resāla Ahwāziya*, addressed to him by Imam Ja'far al-Şādeq. According to a story related by 'Ammār Sejestānī, 'Abdallāh was a Zaydī Shi'ite before he met the Imam on a trip to Medina (Qohpā'i, *Maǰma' al-reǰāl* IV, n.p., n.d., pp. 57-58). The governor's grandson Aḥmad b. 'Alī Najāšī refers to him and to the *resāla* (*Reǰāl*, Bombay, 1317/1899, p. 147). The text has been published (*Maǰmū'a-ye rasā'el-e Şahīd*, Tehran, 1313/1895, pp. 327-33).
