



## ABŪ JA'FAR B. AḤMAD

**ABŪ JA'FAR B. AḤMAD** B. 'ABDALLĀH B. ḤABAŠ, mid- to late 3rd/9th century astronomer, son of a famous astronomer from Marv. Ebn al-Nadīm, followed by Ebn al-Qeṭī, attributed to Abū Ja'far a *Ketāb al-aṣṭorlāb al-mosaṭṭaḥ* ("Book of the plane astrolabe"). A manuscript of the text survives in Paris.
