ABŪ MANŞŪR ṬŪSĪ, mathematician. Apparently sometime during the 9th/15th century Abū Manşūr wrote two works preserved in a manuscript at Florence: 1. *Resāla fī ‘elm al-ḥesāb* (“Epistle concerning computation”); 2. *Resāla fī’l-ḡabr wa’l-moqābala* (“Epistle concerning algebra”).
