



## ABU'L-MOẒAFFAR ḲvĀFĪ

**ABU'L-MOẒAFFAR ḲvĀFĪ**, AḤMAD B. MOḤAMMAD B. AL-MOẒAFFAR, d. in Ṭūs in 500/1106, Shafē'ite jurist and traditionist. He was one of the most important students of [Emām-al-ḥaramayn Jovaynī](#) (d. 478/1085) and a friend of Ḡazālī. For some years he served as *qāẓī* of Ṭūs, but he was eventually deposed from office.
