



AḤMADĀVAND

AḤMADĀVAND, a small, sedentary Kurdish tribe of western Iran, inhabiting some five villages in the *dehestān* of Dorū Farāmān, southeast of Kermānšāh. The Aḥmadāvands supported Karīm Khan Zand and were moved to Fārs by that ruler along with other Kurdish tribes. But they returned to the Kermānšāh area after the fall of the Zands.
