



AMMITMANYA

AMMITMANYA (Elamite *am-mi-ut-man-ya*), an Iranian, to whom were entrusted 215 (?) BAR of grain provided for provisions at Tukraš (Ti-ik-raš, otherwise normally Tuk-raš), at the estate of Da-a-ya-u-ka (R. T. Hallock, *Persepolis Fortification Tablets*, Chicago, 1969, p. 193, no. 581). The Iranian name probably consists of **hamid-* (cf. Avestan *hamid-paiti-*) and **manya-* (= Avestan *mainiia-*).
