



ANJOMAN-E EŞFAHĀN

ANJOMAN-E EŞFAHĀN, a weekly paper founded in Isfahan on 21 Du'l-qa'da 1324/6 January 1906, by Sayyed Serāĵ-al-dīn Şadr Jabal-e 'Āmelī (1252/1836-37-1314 Š./1935) as the organ of the Provincial Council of Isfahan (Anĵoman-e Mellī-e Eşfahān) for the main purpose of publishing proceedings of the Council. It continued publication until 8 Du'l-ḥejja 1329/30 November 1911.
