



## ANJOMAN (NEWSPAPER)

---

**ANJOMAN**, a newspaper published in Tabrīz in Raġab 1325/February-March 1907 by the Anġoman-e Mellī of Tabrīz, which had previously published *Rūz-nāma-ye mellī* and *Jarīda-ye mellī*. The former was the first newspaper to be published in Tabrīz after the proclamation of the Constitution. It was published two to four times a week, at first lithographed and later printed, and was said to have a circulation of 5,000. Among the contributors were the founder Mīrzā 'Alī Akbar Khan, Sayyed 'Alī-Akbar Wakīlī, and Mīrzā Moġammad Ġanīzāda. It is believed to have lasted about four years.
