



## ‘ARŪZĪ, YŪSOF

---

‘ARŪZĪ, YŪSOF, rhetorician and poet of the 4th/10th century, samples of whose poetry are preserved in the *Loġat-e fors* and the *Moʃam*. Rādūyānī mentions a work on ‘arūz (metrics) composed in Persian by a certain Abū Yūsof who is most likely to be identical with Yūsof ‘Arūzī. Nothing else is known about him.
