



BAḲTĪĀRĪ VI. LOṬF-‘ALĪ KHAN ŠOJĀ’-AL-SOLṬĀN

Loṭf-‘Alī Khan **Šojā’-al-Solṭān**, then **Amīr-e Mofakḵam**, Baḳtīārī chief (1862-1946), fourth son of Emāmqolī Khan, known as Ḥājī Īlḵānī. As chief of the personal guard of Moḥammad-‘Alī Shah Qājār, he was opposed to the march of the Baḳtīārīs on Tehran in July, 1909, and was one of the few Baḳtīārī chiefs not to participate in it. He was *īlḵānī* of the Baḳtīārī tribe 1930-33.
