



BESTĀMĪ, BĀYAZĪD

BESTĀMĪ (Baštāmī), ABŪ MOḤAMMAD **BĀYAZĪD** b. ‘Enāyat-Allāh, a 10th/16th-century *faqīh* and Sufi of Khorasan. Born in Bestām, he spent most of his life in Mašhad, a fact alluded to in the title of one of his works, *Toḥfat al-marżīya le’l-hazra al-rażawīya*. The subject of this book is *taslīm* (submission), and it is therefore sometimes known as *Resāla-ye taslīm*. He also wrote books on the question of predetermination and on the timing of the five canonical prayers.
