



BOHLŪL

BOHLŪL, a weekly comic illustrated paper founded by Shaikh 'Alī 'Erāqī in Tehran in early 1329/1911 and subsequently edited by Asad-Allāh Khan Pārsī and Shaikh Ḥasan. The paper's editors were firm supporters of the [Democrat Party](#), and each number contained cartoons and caricatures related to current events, as well as satirical poems and articles. *Bohlul* enjoyed considerable popularity and was suppressed on a number of occasions. During 1302 Š./1923 it appeared for a time as a substitute for *Āzādī*.
