DEŽ, a weekly of news and politics associated with the Tudeh Party (see [COMMUNISM ii](#)) that began publication on 6 Ԡordād 1322 Š./27 May 1943 in Tehran and continued with some interruptions until June 1953. Its publisher and director was Nowḡar Āšūrī. From 1950 until the summer of 1953 it was published with interruptions in place of *Be sūy-e āyanda*, the unofficial organ of the then underground Tudeh Party. Issues of *Dež* are found in the Central Library of Tehran University, the Asian Institute in Shiraz, and the Library of Congress.
