



DĪN MOḤAMMAD KHAN

DĪNMOḤAMMAD KHAN b. Olūs Khan, the Uzbek prince who, with his brother ‘Alī Solṭān, joined Shah Ṭahmāsb’s camp in 943/1536-37 during the latter’s campaign in Khorasan against ‘Obayd-Allāh Khan, the Uzbek ruler of Bukhara. He was given the governorship of Nesā and Abīvard. In 945/1538-39 he regained Kvārazm from ‘Abd-al-‘Azīz, son of ‘Obayd-Allāh Khan.
