



JĀKI

JĀKI, a group of Lor tribes in the Kuhgiluya region of eastern Khuzesan. They comprise the [tribal confederations](#) of the Čahārboniča (or Čarboniča) and the Lirāvi. The Čahārboniča, in turn, comprises the [Boir Aḥmadi](#), Čorām (see ČERĀM), [Došmanziāri](#), and Novi tribes. The Lirāvi, on the other hand, comprise the [Bahma'i](#), Šir 'Ali, Ṭayyebi, and Yusofi tribes.
