the northernmost and largest of the five traditional Ṭāleš khanates (*Ḳamsa-ye Ṭavāleš*) in western Gilān. It includes the catchment basin of the river Kargānrud and several smaller streams to its north. In the administrative reform of 1937 Kargānrud became a rural district (*dehestān*) in Markazi district (*baḳš*), Ṭavāleš sub-province (*šahrestān*). In the 1998 reform, Kargānrud became one of the districts of the sub-province of Ṭāleš.
